August 28, 1937 - June 8, 2020

Frank "Stub" Clark, age 82 of Moundsville, WV died Monday, June 8, 2020 in Liza's Place, Wheeling, WV.

He was born August 28, 1937 in Greene County, PA, the son of the late Luther F. and Nellie Gregg Clark.

He was US Army Veteran; a retired employee from Bayer Corporation and B&O Railroad; Owned "Stub's Home Plate Lounge"; was a member of 1st Christian Church of Cameron; a 50 year member of Earl Francis Post #3 American Legion; officiated High School and College Games; and sponsored many Baseball teams throughout the years.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two wives, Beverly Clark and Mary Lou Clark; a son, Troy Clark; a granddaughter, Willow Kershuk; a brother, Forest Clark; and four sisters, Mildred Watson, Lillian Kalman, Doris Mathews, and Marjorie Yoho.

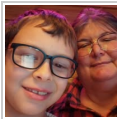
