June 7, 1923 - February 7, 2015

Frank A. Rusinko, age 91 of Glen Dale died Saturday, February 7, 2015 at his home.

He was born June 7, 1923 in Glen Dale, WV son of the late John and Mary Von Druckova Rusinko.

He was a college professor of Biology and Chemistry for over 31 years, having taught at West Liberty State College and at Clark College, Atlanta, GA. He assisted in redesigning the Dental Hygiene program at WLSC so the program could achieve national accreditation. He was the recipient of the Rockefeller Foundation Award for Molecular Biology in 1964 and was a member of St. Jude Catholic Church, Glen Dale. Frank spent 5 years proudly serving his country with the US Army occupational forces of Germany as a translator and aide while traveling extensively throughout Europe. He always took his favorite Royal Copenhagen Porcelain Seated Pointer Puppy named "Fluffy" after his boyhood dog, who many referred to as his "protector". He served on the first symposium task force for AIDS in Atlanta, GA in 1981 and studied at the Army School of Language in Monterey, CA while in service. Frank was quite articulate, had beautiful handwriting, loved antiques, opera and poetry. Frank will be most remembered for his operatic singing, zest and love of life.

He was preceded in death by four brothers: John, Michael, Joseph Eugene and George Rusinko and four sisters: Anne Grondalski, Helen Buturla, Julia Hannan and Mary Metro.

Survivors include two sisters: Susan Massey of Moundsville and Elizabeth “Betty” Wickham of Louisville, KY; nieces and nephews: Mark, Michael John, Matthew and Melanie Wickham, Jane Krupica, Bob, Tommy, Mary and Marjorie Massey. US Army Chief Warrant Officer John “Anthony” Rusinko, currently serving in Italy.

The family will receive friends on Monday from 4-7pm at the Grisell Funeral Home & Crematory, 400 Jefferson Ave., Moundsville with a vigil service at 4:00pm.
