Fred J. Baxter, age 75 of Proctor, WV, passed away, Thursday February 15, 2024, at WVU Wheeling Hospital.

He was born February 11, 1949, in New Martinsville, WV, the son of Helena Baxter and the late Joseph H. Baxter.

Fred was retired from Lockheed Martin and Northwest Airlines as an Aircraft Mechanic, a US Army Veteran who served during the Vietnam War in Korea. Fred was a member of the St. Joseph Catholic Church in Proctor.
