Gary LeVern Yoho has been called for Heavenly Duty at age 77.

He was born Sept. 4, 1942 in Reynolds Memorial Hospital, Glen Dale, WV.

He died Oct. 30, 2019 at his home on Long Ridge, Hannibal, OH.

Raising to the rank of Sargent E5 in the United States Marine Corp., has served his county proudly for 4 yrs. and 3 months which includes a 6 month Tour-of-Duty in Vietnam plus an additional 2 yrs. in Active Reserves receiving Rifle Expert medals, Good Conduct Medal, Vietnam Medal and a National Defense Service Medal.

Gary served as Commander to two American Legion Posts, 760 in Hannibal, OH and 67 in Sistersville, WV and was also a Life Member of the VFW 9930 in Duffy, OH and 6327 in Sistersville, WV.
