



George "Jack" Fuller Jr.

It is with profound sorrow that we announce the passing of George "Jack" Fuller, Jr., who left us peacefully on the morning of Sunday, March 17, 2024, at Duke Regional Hospital, Durham, NC. Born on March 29, 1940, in Pittsburgh, PA, Jack embarked on a life characterized by service, dedication, and an unwavering love for his family and country.

Jack's educational journey was marked by notable achievements, including attending West Virginia University School of Pharmacy and West Liberty State College School of Business to earn his BA in business administration.

His passion for helping others led him to serve as an emergency medical service assistant in Point Pleasant, WV, and as a medical specialist at Fort Sam Houston, TX.

Jack's professional career was distinguished by his roles as Chief Cost Analyst and Safety Coordinator for Appalachian Power Company in New Haven, WV, followed by his tenure as Safety Supervisor for Foster Wheeler Energy Company. His expertise and dedication took him to several locations, including Detroit Edison at Avoca, Michigan; Delta Refining in Memphis, TN; and other significant sites.

His investment in the stock market was matched by his investment in the lives of his loved ones, always ready to share in laughter and love, particularly with babies, children, and most notably his grandchildren.
