George N. Lewis, age 94

of Glen Dale, WV passed away June 23, 2016 at home.

He was born March 31, 1922 in Moundsville, WV, the son of the late Nassief and Amoon Naufel Lewis.

He was a member of St. Jude Catholic Church, and Our Lady of Lebanon Maronite Catholic Church; a graduate of Moundsville High School, attended the University of Texas, and was a 1947 graduate of West Virginia University College of Business and Economics.

He enlisted in the US Army in 1942, serving as Sergeant Major in the 103rd military government unit in the Asiatic Pacific area of operations during World War II.

For over 40 years, George was the owner and operator of Western Auto Associate businesses.

He was a member of the Moundsville Country Club, Veterans of Foreign Wars, American Legion; 40-8 Legion, Moundsville Elks, Knights of Columbus, Moundsville Eagles, and served as president of the Glen Dale Lions Club.
