Georgia Ilene Leach Jordan, age 92 of Glen Easton, WV died Thursday, June 1, 2017 in Reynolds Memorial Hospital, Glen Dale, WV, surrounded by her daughters.

She was born April 14, 1925 in Glen Dale, the daughter of the late Floyd and Ethel Bartrug Leach.

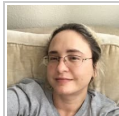

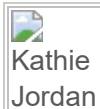
