



## Glen William Stalder Sr.

November 6, 1921 - December 15, 2024

Glen William Stalder Sr., age 103, of Sardis, OH, passed away peacefully at home on Sunday, December 15, 2024.

Born November 6, 1921, in Sardis, OH, Glen was the son of the late Jesse and Ida (Fuchs) Stalder.

A proud U.S. Army veteran of World War II, Glen served in the 1st Cavalry Division 77th Infantry. Throughout his life, he was committed to service and his community. He was a lifelong member of Zion United Church of Christ in Sardis and worked many years as a self-employed farmer and mason. Glen was a dedicated member of the American Legion Post #760 in Hannibal, OH, where he was honored as Legionnaire of the Year in 2019.

Glen was preceded in death by his beloved wife of 61 years, Juanita Young Stalder; daughter-in-law Brenda Stalder; two sisters, Helen Reusser and Martha Winkler; and his great-granddaughter Isabella Stalder; great-grandson Liam Stalder.
