Goodrich, Rev. Robert A., Jr., age 58 of Columbus, OH, formerly of Moundsville, WV died Thursday, January 29, 2009 in Riverside Methodist Hospital, Columbus.

He was a retired Episcopal Priest, having served for 25 years; the president of the last graduating class of Moundsville High School; a Marshall University Graduate; received his Masters of Theology from Duquesne University; was a Mason and a Shriner; a former schoolteacher at Brooke High School; and an aide to Congressman Ken Hechler.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, David Eastman Goodrich.
