Henry "Bud" Gump, age 91, of New Martinsville, WV, formerly of Akron, OH, died Sunday, October 22, 2017 at his home.

He was born December 12, 1925 in Smithfield, WV, a son of the late James Henry and Ola Agnes Fluharty Gump.

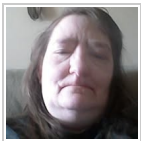
