Herman H. Morris, age 84 of Mt. Olivet, passed away Wednesday, December 14, 2022 at Select Specialty Hospital, Wheeling.

He was born April 27, 1938 in Wheeling, son of the late Herman and Elsie Kadenbach Morris.

Herman retired from Mobay/Miles/Bayer Corporations in 2000 after 38 years of service, a U.S Marine veteran serving from 1957 to 1960, served as a presidential advisor to George H. Bush #41, was awarded the Republican presidential Legion of Merritt. Enjoyed donating his time on behalf of the citizens of WV and our country, always carried in his heart the concerns of the American people and put his best foot forward on their behalf while quietly working behind the scenes. He was a longtime member of the Garvins Lane First Church of God, enjoyed volunteering his time at the Catholic Charities and Hope U.M.C. food banks and received great pleasure from giving out ball caps with FBI (firm believer in Jesus) embroidered on them.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by two sisters: Dorothy Altman and Clara Morris.

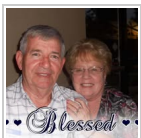
