After she lost everything in a home fire, her entrepreneurial spirit to survive and support her kids began with the first tanning salon in the area, Tropical Fun 'N Sun. Mom was the original owner and operator of Choo Choo's Restaurant. And the community continued to enjoy her homemade

soups at her most recent endeavor, the Speedway Diner. To this day, many of our friends continues to call her mom, and many other recounts her generosity with their needs. Always helping her employees whether it was paying their utility or medical bills, or simply advancing an interest-free loan. She was generous to a fault.
