November 14, 1929 - April 4, 2019

Jack Eugene Mason, age 89 of Cameron, WV died Thursday, April 04, 2019 in Richmond Place Rehabilitation and Health Center, Lexington, KY.

He was born November 14, 1929 in Aleppo, PA the son of the late Willard Christopher and Mary Marjorie Antill Mason.

He grew up in Greene County, PA, where he attended Rogersville High School. After his marriage in 1957 to Virginia Kay Mason, he and his family lived on Wayman's Ridge, and later moved to Wolf Run outside of Cameron. He was a US Army Korean War Veteran; was employed with the former Marx Toy; and was a retired employee from Triangle Conduit, Glen Dale.
