James "Jim" Dangel, age 65 of Apple Creek, OH, formerly of Powhatan Point, OH, died Saturday, May 28, 2016 in Cleveland Clinic, Cleveland, Ohio. He was born May 4, 1951 in Martins Ferry, OH, a son of the late Paul and Donaldda Kriechbaum Dangel.
