Jerry Lynn Derrow, 77, of Moundsville WV passed away peacefully at home on March 7, 2026, after a courageous battle with a neurological disease. He was born on February 6, 1949, in Glen Dale, WV, the son of the late Richard E. and Irene J. (Suhodolski) Derrow.
