Jessie K. Lannan, age 98 of Glen Dale died Tuesday, February 3, 2015 at Mound View Health Care Center, Moundsville.

She was born February 12, 1916 in Perry County, Illinois, the daughter of the late Adam Oliver and Mary Chapman Lynch.

She was a retired teacher from John Marshall High School where she taught from 1968 until her retirement in 1986, a member of the Moundsville Baptist Church, the Salvation Army Auxiliary and the Reynolds Memorial Hospital Volunteer Auxiliary, a member of the Alpha Delta Kappa Sorority, Lambda Chapter, the AARP, Retired School Employees and since her retirement she served as a volunteer for meals on wheels.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband: Robert E. Lannan, one son: James Duane Lannan, five brothers and five sisters.
