Jividen, Arlin D., 82, of Moundsville, WV, died Monday, Sept. 3, 2012, in Walkersville, MD.

He was born Nov. 17, 1929, in Tribble, Mason County, WV, the son of the late Roy C. and Ora McCoy Jividen. He was preceded in death by his wife of 51 years, Carma Lee Jividen, in 2010.
