John E. Brookover, age 69, of New Martinsville, WV, passed away Thursday, October 26, 2017 at Wheeling Hospital, Wheeling, WV.

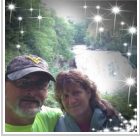

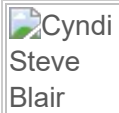

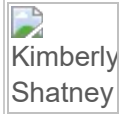
