Talkington, Jon Ellis (Turk), 56, of New Martinsville, WV, died Sunday, October 5, 2014 at his home of an apparent heart attack.

He was born August 7, 1958 in New Martinsville, the son of William L. "Bill" and Beulah Nice Talkington of New Martinsville.

Jon graduated from Magnolia High School with the Class of 1976. He was retired with over 20 years of service as a Journeyman with Boilermakers Local Union 667 out of Winfield, WV. Jon was also a member of the NRA and the American Motorcyclist Assoc.

He served as Air Rifle Coach for the New Martinsville Jaycee Shooting Teams from 1991 through 2002, coaching 12 teams to 12 state championships. He loved the outdoors, hunting, fishing and riding four wheelers and motorcycles. In addition to his parents, Jon is survived by a son, Jon Michael Talkington; and a brother, Percy (Debbie) Talkington, both of New Martinsville; a sister, Belinda Talkington, of Martinsburg, WV; and Alex Glendenning of Paden City, WV, whom he was helping to raise.

Family will receive friends on Tuesday from 2-4 and 6-9 pm at Grisell Funeral Home & Crematory, 751 Third Street, New Martinsville, where funeral services will be held on Wednesday at 1 pm.

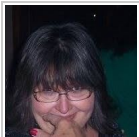

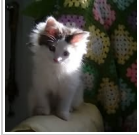

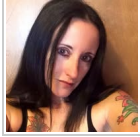
