



Julia Regiec Robinson

September 11, 1923 - March 18, 2017

Julia Regiec Robinson, age 93, passed away on March 18, 2017 at the Good Shepherd Nursing Home, Wheeling, WV.

Julia was born September 11, 1923 in Fairpoint Ohio, daughter of Martin and Agnes Regiec. She lived most of her life in Moundsville, WV except for the past six years in Wheeling WV.

She was a lifelong member of St Francis Xavier Catholic Church.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Russell Robinson of Grayson KY, to whom she was married for 40 years. She lovingly cared for him for a lengthy time when he was severely bed ridden by a stroke.

Julia worked for 34 years in the meat department of the A&P in Moundsville. Russell and Julia had no children but were extraordinarily loving guardians for her baby brother, Johnny, who was born with Down's syndrome.

In addition to her husband, Julia was preceded in death by her parents, who migrated here from Poland: She also survived her 10 siblings: Ann Regiec Rustile, Thomas Regiec, Mary Regiec Gorby, Sophie Regiec DeBolt, Stanley (Butch) Regiec, Helen Regiec Adamiak, Josephine Regiec Stout, Veronica Regiec, Angela Regiec Marchlenski and John Regiec.

Julia was especially known for her engaging smile and kindness and generosity. She was an exceptionally caring aunt to numerous (over 50) nieces and nephews.

Julia flourished at the Altenheim Retirement Community in Wheeling for almost six years and was so grateful for the extraordinary service, friendship

and care provided by everyone there. She especially loved Melissa, whose exceptional kindness and companionship caused her to be affectionately known as Julia's "honorary" granddaughter.

Julia was very healthy for her whole life and only in December did she give up independent living.

The family also wishes to thank the management, staff and caregivers at Good Shepherd Nursing Home and Amedysis Hospice for their consideration and care the past three months.

Per her previously made arrangements with her executor, Carol Adamiak Yarnall, Julia's body has been cremated by Grisell Funeral Home & Crematory, Moundsville.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Tuesday, March 28 at 10am St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church, Moundsville.

After the Mass her cremains will be buried alongside her husband in Riverview Cemetery.

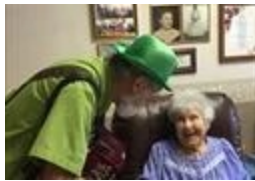
