Klug, Robert "Bob" A., age 74, formerly of Moundsville and St. Joseph's Settlement died Sunday, April 15, 2012 at New Martinsville Health Care Center.

He was born June 13, 1937 in Wetzel County, the son of the late Paul J. and Lena M. Weigand Klug.

Bob had worked several jobs in his lifetime, he had a shoe repair shop in Paden City, he worked as a maintenance man at Sistersville Nursing Home, a carpet layer for Wells Eakins in New Martinsville, a janitor at Reynolds Memorial Hospital, and a night watchman/ maintenance worker for Klug Brother Inc. from where he retired.

He was member of The Knights of Columbus Council 1907 and F.O. Eagles #499, and a member of St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a niece, Vicki Klug.
