Dowler, Lois Woods, age 89 of Claysville, PA, formerly of Moundsville, WV died Tuesday, April 14, 2015, following a protracted illness.

Born March 9, 1926, she was the sixth child of the late Clarence and Hazel Maxwell Woods; she grew up on the family's commercial dairy farm on Fork Ridge.
