Long, Kermit Howard, 81, of Main Street, Middlebourne, WV, died Wednesday, December 23, 2009 at Marietta Memorial Hospital, Marietta, Ohio.

He was born June 22, 1928 in Little Owls Head, near Wick, WV, a son of the late Golden and Bessie Hadley Long.

He was a graduate of Tyler County High School, Salem College and WVU. Kermit was a retired teacher and principal, working in WV, Ohio, Florida, and for 30 years overseas in Italy, Turkey and Germany with the Department of Defense. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in New Martinsville; Masonic Lodge; American Legion; and was a U.S. Air Force veteran of the Korean Conflict, during which time he worked at the Pentagon. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by four brothers, William, Gale, James A. Sr. and Robert Long; and a sister, Imogene.
