Lorhn "Sid" Gorby, age 85 of Moundsville, WV died Thursday, June 4, 2020 in Reynolds Memorial Hospital, Glen Dale, WV.

He was born February 27, 1935 in Glen Easton, WV the son of the late William James and Bessie L. Henry Gorby.
