January 31, 1929 - June 7, 2017

Lt. Joseph S. "Junior" Davis, age 88 of Wheeling passed away peacefully at his home, Wednesday, June 7, 2017 surrounded by his family.

He was born January 31, 1929, in Wheeling, the son of the late Joseph William and Mary Jacovetty Davis.

Joe was a retired Chief of Detectives for the Wheeling Police Department with 42 years of service, a member of the F.O.P., VFW, American Legion and a US Army Korean War Veteran..
