She was a specialty care provider for Northwood Health Systems; a teacher's aide with Marshall County Schools; and a member of the Christian Church in Jacktown, PA.

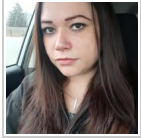

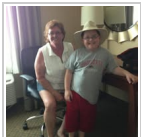
