April 30, 1927 - September 26, 2013

Chaplin, Mary Ann "Cuppy", age 86, of Duffy, Ohio, died Thursday, September 26, 2013 at Wheeling Hospital, Wheeling, WV.

She was born April 30, 1927 in Newell, PA, the daughter of the late Demarco and Anna Rocca Dandrea.
