



MaryLou Mason Mezzatesta

September 4, 1958 - November 13, 2015

MaryLou (Mason) Mezzatesta, 57, of Moundsville, passed away at home after a 3 ½ year battle with pancreatic cancer, surrounded by her loving family. She was born in Marshall County, the daughter of Jack Eugene Mason and Virginia “Kay” Bacher Mason of Cameron. Mary Lou graduated from Cameron High School in 1976 and attended West Virginia University as a National Merit Scholar. She was a Field Engineer, business owner, a lobbyist in Charleston and later was Administrative Assistant to the House Education Committee. Most recently, she was employed as an oil and gas abstractor with Western Land Services of Canonsburg, PA.

Mary Lou loved building and remodeling, happiest in her kitchen, baking goodies for family and friends. She loved traveling to warm climates with beaches, such as Hawaii, Folly Beach, SC and St. Martin - taking her children, grandchildren to Disney World as often as possible. She loved being with her family.

A native of Wolf Run, near Cameron, she grew up a country girl, picking berries and playing 4-H ball in a community of loving friends. She lived in Romney for many years and was very involved in all of her sons' school activities including Boy Scouts, FFA and the team Mom of various sports they participated in. She was a member of Cameron VFW Auxiliary.

She is survived by her husband, Jerry Mezzatesta, of Moundsville and Romney; her sons – Grant (Brittany) Clark of Romney, and Michael Clark of Moundsville; a step-son, Jeff (Luann) Mezzatesta of Georgetown, SC;

grandchildren – Brileigh and Avery of Romney, and Asher and Mary-Adalyn of Georgetown, SC; her parents, Jack and Kay Mason of Wolf Run; brother, Ken (Charlotte) Blake of Moundsville; sisters - Barbara Eyer of Moundsville; Lori Shakespeare of Columbia, SC; Betty L. Nettles (Allen Leaphart) of Lexington, SC; and Connie (Doug) Rine of Richmond, KY; her first husband, Frank C. “Stub” Clark of Moundsville; and many loving aunts, uncles, nieces and nephews.

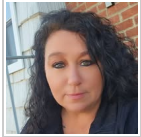
