Maxine Kathleen Smith, 86, of Moundsville, WV, died Wednesday, May 29, 2024, in WVU Reynolds Memorial Hospital, Glen Dale, WV.

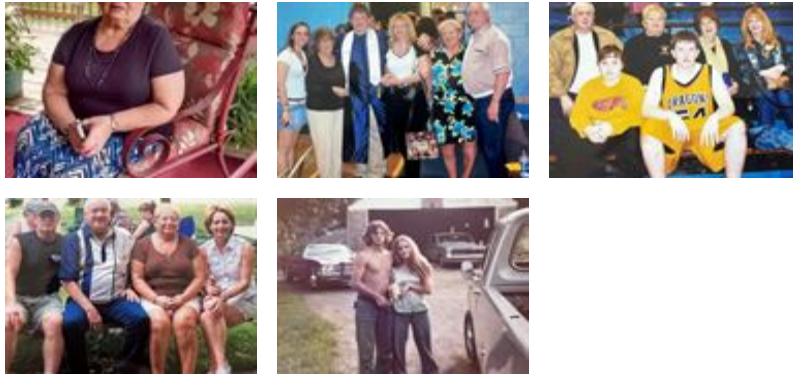

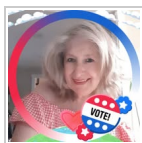
