McPeek, Eugene “Gene” William, age 69, spent his life in service to our country, died December 3, 2009 with family at his bedside after a short battle with cancer.

Born in Moundsville West Virginia, A devoted Christian, Eugene William McPeek moved to the outskirts of D.C and settled into Olney, Montgomery County where he resided for 40 Years. Upon his retirement in 1999 Eugene moved to Heritage Harbor in Annapolis.

Eugene William Mcpeek began serving his county in 1958 where he served as an Military Policeman in the US Army. Returning to civilian life, he first became a DC Police Officer, and then a US Secret Service Officer In the later capacity, his tenure included serving on the protection detail for Vice President. Hubert H. Humphrey. Further service to the nation followed as Eugene moved on to the FAA for a brief period of time before embarking upon a long and illustrious career with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission where he held progressively responsible positions focused on protecting our nation’s nuclear power. In June of 1999 Eugene William Mcpeek was honored and thanked by President William Jefferson Clinton on the occasion of his retirement.

He received his Bachelors of Arts from California Western University in 1977 Eugene was a member of the American Society for Industrial Security, the Association of Federal Investigators and The U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary. Beloved husband of Carla Cooper McPeek, He is survived by two daughters Margaret Connell of Calvert County and Meghan Hornbacher of Baltimore

County, six grandchildren, and a countless number of friends and people whose life he touched.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday at 1pm at Halcyon Hills Memorial Park Chapel with Pastor Pat Carlson officiating.
