Milosavljevic, Radic, age 89, of State Route 556, Clarington, Ohio died Saturday, March 15, 2008 in Woodsfield Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. He was born July 15, 1918 in Serbia, the son of the late Stanko and Svilka Joksimovic.

He was a dairy farmer, a member of the St. John's United Church of Christ in Powhatan Point and the Serbian Greek Orthodox Church in Steubenville, Ohio. He was a US Army veteran of WWII and a member of the American Legion Post 768 in Beallsville.
