She was born July 27, 1946 in Marshall County, WV the daughter of the late John Clifford and Florence Beryl Connor Burge.

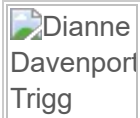
Mylene was a former custodian for the North American Coal Company, #6 Mine.
