Naoma Ann Boram, 89, of Wheeling went to her eternal home on Sunday, February 24, 2019.

She was born October 3, 1929 in Clarksburg, WV; the daughter of the late Walter Hardman and Gertrude Hamilton Hardman.

Naoma was a graduate of Washington Irving High School in Clarksburg and graduated with honors from West Liberty University in West Liberty, WV, with a degree in accounting.
