



## Nikki Ann Vucelick

February 8, 1949 - October 13, 2013

Vucelick, Nikki Ann, age 64, of New Martinsville, WV, formerly of Moundsville, WV, died Sunday, October 13, 2013 at the New Martinsville Care Center. She was born February 8, 1949 in Glen Dale, WV, the daughter of the late Nick M. Vucelick and Lennis L. (Young) Vucelick Feeney.

Nikki was a former LPN at Reynolds Memorial Hospital in Glen Dale; a member of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church in New Martinsville; Marshall County Animal Rescue League; a former member of P.E.T.A. and A.S.P.C.A. She was also a former commissioner of the Housing Authority in McMechen, WV.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by a sister, Tana Vucelick; a brother, Robert A. Vucelick; and her stepfather, Martin Feeney. Survivors include two sisters, Robyn A. (Mark) Durant of Paden City, WV and Lois D. Vucelick of Parkersburg, WV; three nieces, Shauna Louise Durant, Nikki Adkins and Tana Vucelick; and three nephews, Jeffrey Vucelick, Anthony Douglas and Jason Durant.
