Nonnie W. Hunter Anderson, age 89, of New Martinsville, WV, died Wednesday, June 29, 2016 in Liza's Place, Wheeling, WV.

She was born December 16, 1926 in New Martinsville, WV, a daughter of the late Charles Dail and Bessie Dunham Hunter. Nonnie was raised by her grandparents, George W. and Nora Adams Hunter.

She was a retired nurse at the former Conalco, Hannibal, OH, with 32 years of service. She was a member of St. Ann's Episcopal Church, New Martinsville; she graduated from Magnolia High School in 1944, St. Joseph School of Nursing, Parkersburg, WV in 1947, a Cadet Corp.
