Paul W. Russell, Jr., 75, of Tiltonsville, Ohio; died Sunday, March 2, 2025 in Trinity West Hospital, Steubenville, Ohio.

He was born May 7, 1949 in Wheeling, WV; the son of the late Paul W. Russell, Sr. and Vera Braun Russell.

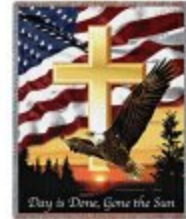
