Peabody, Robert "Snake", age 85 of Glen Dale, WV died Sunday, January 8, 2012 in Reynolds Memorial Hospital, Glen Dale.

He was born June 25, 1926 in Glen Dale, the son of the late Norman and Nellie Bea Buzzard Peabody.

He was a WWII Army Veteran; a retired buyer from the former Allied Chemical; a member of Glen Dale United Methodist Church, BPO Elks #282, Moose, FO Eagles #499, Earl Francis Post #3 American Legion, and Moundsville VFW Post #437.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by eleven brothers and sisters.
