Phyllis Lee Taylor Hill, age 90 of Moundsville, WV died Monday, March 12, 2018 in Wheeling Hospital Medical Park, Wheeling, WV.

She was born July 7, 1927 in Moundsville, the daughter of the late Charles M. and Celesta J. Morgan Taylor.

She was the co-owner of the former Hill's Market for 43 years; a 50 year member of the Moundsville Order of Eastern Star #86; a member of Moundsville Baptist Church, Moundsville Tuesday Arts Club, Wheeling Women's Club; and WIBA Bowling; and a former member of US Bowling Congress.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death in 2005 by her husband, Donald L. Hill; two sisters, Marietta Parshall, and Wanda Rhodes; and a brother, Charles K. Taylor.

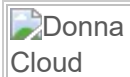

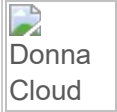
