Potts, Ray B. age 92, of Sardis, OH died April 4, 2008 in Wetzel County Hospital, New Martinsville, WV.

He was born April 12, 1915 in Duffy, OH the son of the late Melvin and Anna Morrow Potts.

He was one of the members who organized the Sardis Volunteer Fire Department and became its first Fire Chief, a Gulf Oil Distributor for Monroe and Belmont counties and the owner of Potts Towing Company.
