August 29, 1936 - November 30, 2018

Raymond “Ray” Francis Wojcicki, 82, of Mt. Olivet, died Friday, November 30, 2018 at Peterson Rehabilitation Center, Wheeling.

He was born August 29, 1936, in Wheeling, the son of the late Cashimer and Stephanie “Stella” Grunski Wojcicki.

Ray was a mechanic at Wheeling Pittsburgh Steel with forty years of service, a US Airforce Veteran, having served in the Korean War and a Catholic by Faith.
