Raymond W. "Raymie" Woods, age 80 of Moundsville, WV passed away Wednesday, December 7, 2022 in WVU Wheeling Hospital, Wheeling, WV. He was born February 24, 1942 in Glen Dale, WV the son of the late C. Raymond and Naomi "Sis" Wilson Woods.
