Rex V. Justice, age 89, of New Martinsville, WV died Monday, March 27, 2017 at Reynolds Memorial Hospital surrounded by his family.

He was born December 29, 1927 in Maryville, TN, the son of the late Hubert and Georgie Wilcox Justice.

He was a US Army veteran, a retired Shift Supervisor at Ormet Corporation, an avid golfer, a member of Moose Lodge #931, and American Legion Post #28.
