Rine, Diana Sue, age 63, of Rock Hill, SC formerly of Moundsville, WV died after a brief illness on Friday, February 18, 2011, surrounded by her loving family and in the caring hands of the staff and professionals at the Wayne T. Patrick Hospice House in Rock Hill, SC. Mrs. Rine was born on September 5, 1947 in Clarksburg, WV. She was the daughter of Fred and Deloris Lasure Ensminger of Glen Dale, WV. She married her High School sweetheart, Phillip C. Rine of Moundsville, on Christmas Eve, 1966. Mrs. Rine graduated from the Ohio Valley General Hospital School of Radiology in 1967 as a Registered X-Ray Technician. Whether serving on a hospital staff, at an urgent care center, or for an arthritis center, Mrs. Rine touched countless lives during her 25 year career in radiology. As a devoted follower of Jesus Christ and having lived in seven different states, Mrs. Rine was an active member of a number of local churches in her life, most recently the First Baptist Church of Rock Hill, SC. Diana's love for God's Word was exhibited by her attendance at weekly women's Bible studies, her membership in the Gideon's International Women's Auxiliary for over 30 years, and her recent service on the Liberty University Board of Regents. Mrs. Rine delighted in serving others as a member of various professional and civic associations. She was inducted into the Moundsville chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star in 1980, and served as Hospitality Chair for the 2008 Annual Meeting of the National Freight Transportation Association. Diana also faithfully supported the Disabled Veterans of America and a number of other organizations dedicated to helping

less fortunate members of society. Her daily pastimes included reading the newspaper, watching The Weather Channel, and enjoying a good cup of hot tea. In addition to her mother and father, Mrs. Rine is survived by her grateful husband, Phillip C. Rine of Rock Hill, SC, a daughter, Tricia Lynn (Brooks) Leach of Gahanna, OH and a son, Phillip Jesse (Rebecca) Rine, Ph.D. of Charlottesville, VA. She dearly loved her three grandchildren: Gideon Brooks, Gabriel Calvin and Grace Renee Leach. She is further survived by her sister, Carol (Daniel) Butler of Glen Dale and her brother, Steven (Robin) Ensminger of Morristown, TN, as well as many nieces, nephews, other Ensminger and Rine relatives, neighbors and countless friends. The family will receive friends on Wednesday from 2-4 & 7-9pm at the Grisell Funeral Home & Crematory, 400 Jefferson Ave., Moundsville, WV where funeral services will be held on Thursday at 1:00pm with Reverend Darrell Gabbard officiating.
