



## Robert B. "Bob" Corbett

February 3, 1942 - July 5, 2017

Robert B. "Bob" Corbett, age 75, of Hannibal, OH, died Wednesday, July 5, 2017 at Ohio State University Hospital, Columbus, Ohio.

He was born February 3, 1942 in Bellaire, OH, a son of the late Richard and Mildred Munjas Corbett.
