Robert Ray "Bob" Scott, 78, of McMechen, WV, died Saturday, April 17, 2021 at Wheeling Hospital.

Bob's three greatest loves were God, his wife, Marsha Jean Scott, and his son, Robert C. Scott.

He was born September 25, 1942 in Glen Dale; the son of the late Adrian and Mildred Booher Scott.

He was a former employee with Triangle Conduit, a custodian for Marshall County Schools, and security officer at Reynolds Memorial Hospital; formerly volunteered locally for the Department of Emergency Services; and loved his years coaching youth sports for Marshall County.

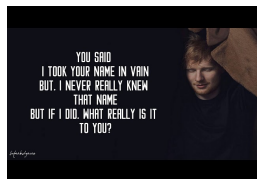
