Roger Hubbs, 82, of Moundsville, died Saturday, November 25, 2023 at home. He was born July 25, 1941 in Glen Easton, WV; the son of the late Marion K. and Helena Blake Hubbs.

Roger was a retired rural mail carrier for the US Post Office and dairy farmer; a veteran of the US Army, serving during the Vietnam War being awarded the Purple Heart; member of the Church of Christ, Farm Bureau, Cameron VFW, and Cameron American Legion; and a life-time member of the Marshall County Fairboard.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by one brother, Marion "Dean" Hubbs.
