Rogerson "Roger" E. Dorsey, age 90, of Glen Dale, WV, died Sunday, December 11, 2022 at Liza's Place.

He was born January 21, 1932 in Wheeling, WV the son of the late Howard M. Dorsey Sr and Mary Ann Dorsey.

He was honorably discharged from the Air Force as a Staff Sergeant in the 48th Fighter Interceptor Squadron which protected the US homeland during the Korean Conflict. He had responsibilities for jet engine repairs.

He was retired from B&W Tubing in Alliance, OH; he was a member of Pleasant Hill United Methodist Church; and was an avid country music fan, as well as country Gospel and hymns. He was an active attendee of Harmon Creek "Pickin and Grinnin" in Weirton, WV.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Donna Dorsey; a brother, Howard M. Dorsey Jr; a granddaughter, Christine Dorsey; and a niece, Brenda Stein and nephew, William Howard "Bill" Dorsey.

Surviving are his son, John (Liz) Dorsey; a granddaughter, Faith (Patrick) VanScyoc; three great- grandchildren, Malory, Cloe and Aaron VanScyoc; niece, Jo Ann; nephews, Russell, Glenn, Tom, Bryan, David, Leslie, and Kevin.
