Ronald Eugene Carney, age 84 of Moundsville, WV went to his eternal reward on Wednesday, January 11, 2017.

He was born January 13, 1932 in Moundsville, the son of the late Floyd and Bessie Huff Carney.

He was a 1949 graduate of Moundsville High School, and attended WVU studying music which he loved. He was a listener of all genre of music ranging from Jazz, Classical, Country, Bluegrass and Christian; and also loved to play the piano.

He served 4 years as a US Navy Korean War Veteran, during which time he traveled to many countries and was thrilled to go to Ireland, the land of his ancestors; he retired from Allied/Olin Chemical Plant upon their closure; was a member of Moundsville VFW Post #437, American Legion Earl Francis Post #3; and Moundsville Four Square Church, where he served in the music department, and was a past member of the board.

He loved sports and was a Pittsburgh Pirates and Steelers Football fan, and an avid fan of WVU football and basketball; and enjoyed fishing and golfing as his hobbies.

Survivors include his wife of almost 60 years, Glenna Hammack Carney; his children, Tara Carney (Michel), Sheila (Christopher) Brown, and Jeffrey Carney; a granddaughter, Kayla (Phillip) Ewing; two great-grandchildren, Elizabeth and Thomas Ewing; and many cousins and friends, all who will miss him.

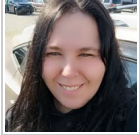
