Ronald "Mac" Lee McCormick, age 74, of Triadelphia, passed away on Tuesday, April 2, 2024, at home.

He was born November 5, 1949, in Waynesburg, PA, son of the late Harold and Leona Breese McCormick.

He was a member of the Plumbers & Steamfitters Union; Christian by faith; member of Viola Sportsman Club & Fraternal Order of Eagles; former owner/operator of Maxi Kool Heating & Air Conditioning; enjoyed fishing, hunting, and was an avid outdoorsman.

He was a U.S. Army Vietnam veteran from 1969-1971 where he received 1st Oak Leaves Cluster, Good Conduct medal, National Defense medal, bronze stars for 3 years of service, Vietnam Campaign medal, and worked with automatic weapons and was a sharp shooter.
