Ronald William "Ron" Tarr, age 85, went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, March 3, 2019.

He was born March 14, 1933, in Wheeling, WV, son of the late William Drexel and Alma (Armbruster) Tarr.

Ron served in the U. S. Navy as an Aviation Machinist Mate, 3rd Class Petty Officer and was stationed in Port Lyautey (Kenitra), Morocco. He was intrigued with the country, and upon retirement as Director of Corporate Credit of Wheeling-Pittsburgh Steel, revisited the area. 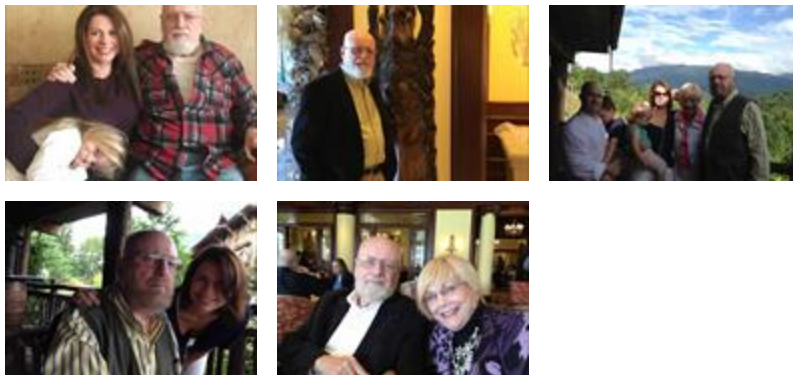
